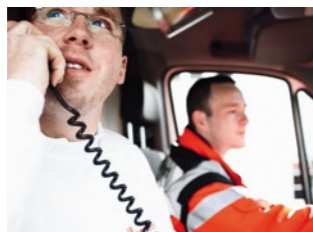


Rescuing with all your strength. Wins vital seconds!

On land, in the water or in the air: our search and rescue staff and emergency doctors are quick to help wherever they are needed. The Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe was set up for this purpose in 1952. Today, we deploy our rescue teams more than 850,000 times each year, we operate more than 230 rescue stations



in Germany and our staff ensure the security at thousands of events. Our employees and volunteers work together hand in hand to save lives with the help of the latest technologies. We use simulations to continually train our teams, making sure that in a real emergency, they will win the vital seconds that could save a life. You can rely on the Johanniter!

The Christian roots of the Johanniter have shaped our approach to children's and youth services. In our nurseries, we want to convey even to the youngest children the values that we consider vital: consideration, responsibility towards others and helpfulness. of age-appropriate ways to get involved, experience a community, and learn about and live out social values within our First Aid teams in schools and our youth groups. Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe was founded in 1952, and is represented by over 300 national, regional, and local associations throughout the Federal Republic of Germany. Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe is a chapter of the Johanniter Order and a registered association in accordance with German legislature. Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe is a professional association of Diakonisches Werk of the Evangelical Church in Germany, and is recognised as a voluntary relief organization in accordance with the first Geneva Convention (article 26) dated August 12, 1949. Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe is supported by around 17,000 fulltime employees and 31,000 volunteers, and more than 1.2 million people are sustaining members.

Statutory tasks include:

- First-aid and medical services
- Ambulance flights and medical evacuation from abroad
- Civil protection and disaster preparedness
- Youth work and work with children
- Hospice work
- Management and involvement in social welfare stations
- Additional social services, such as meals on wheels
- International assistance

Johanniter offer a range of care services to support people in old age, during illness or after an accident – temporarily or for the long term. Naturally, the services we provide, such as home emergency calls, meals-on-wheels, outpatient care, transport services and care homes, are focused on good quality and reliability. But



beyond that, we always look to the individual with his or her very own needs and worries. We take care of each individual with time, attention and affection. We aim to do more than simply serve needs. We want to preserve and protect independence, quality of life and happiness.



Helping with a world of experience. Gives a new lease of life!

What is especially important to us in international humanitarian work is that we improve the living conditions of people in need as permanently as possible. We do this with the help of experienced aid workers. For instance, we improve primary health care units, train and develop local staff, fight mal-



nutrition, support people with disabilities through rehabilitation programmes and intervene as quickly as possible after natural disasters to provide general healthcare. In areas that are particularly prone to disasters, we offer First Aid training and disaster prevention.
