Team leading and logistical staff for DE Disaster Response Capacities

Johanniter-Unfall-Hilfe e.V. is looking for motivated **Staff** to join our **DE Disaster Response Capacities** for international disaster response missions on voluntary basis.

Overall Job Purpose:

The leading body of the German disaster response capacities in the frame of rescEU EMT, consisting of Team Leaders, Liaison Officers, Media Officers, Management Support Officers and some other specific staff. The leading body deploys with the team and manages it both operationally and strategically from the field. It is responsible for facilitating exchange between local actors and other teams in the deployment area, ensuring smooth operations, as well as effective coordination and communication during the mission.

Equally important is the role of the logistics officer. Each of the German rescEU EMT capacities is supported by logistics team members who is leading the Base of Operations, are well-versed in the equipment, manage among others the procurement of necessary resources on-site, and coordinate with local suppliers and customs.

Both the leadership functions as well as the logistical functions are required for all three German rescEU EMT capacities. For this reason, all successful applicants will qualify for a joint staff pool.

Position Summary:

The capacities leading body will be responsible for

- coordinating the team

- internal and external communication
- liaison with entities on the ground
- ensure monitoring, controlling and reporting
- mission planning and staff management
- administrative responsibilities on site

The capacities logistics team will be responsible for:

- Preparation and handling of overall logistics-management of the Base of Operation including WASH aspects
- Procurement of material goods
- Preparation and distribution of catering

Required Qualifications:

We are looking for team leaders, logistics staff and other supportive staff with a professional job experience or presenting other relevant, practical experience in (one of) the following or related areas:

- Team Leader
- Chief of Operation
- Chief Medical Doctors
- Management Support Officers
- Liaison Officers
- Safety & Security Officers
- Media Officers
- Logistical staff

On top of that all team members have to meet the following further requirements:

- Citizen of an EU member state or Türkiye
- Minimum age of 21 years
- Good knowledge of English; minimum level B1, preferred level C1
- Good computer skills in Microsoft Office (Word, Excel, Powerpoint)
- Ability to work effectively as a team player
- High stress tolerance
- Willingness to work and live under basic conditions (e.g. sleeping on camp beds in tents) for a minimum of 14 days during a deployment
- Willingness to undergo all necessary vaccinations and medical check-ups
- Arrangement with the employer for a leave of absence on short-term basis for a minimum of 14 days in the event of a mission.

Compensation & Benefits:

- **Compensation for loss of earnings/Insurances:** Continued remuneration during mission, depending on your type of employment at home, insurance package (health, repatriation, indemnity, liability)
- **Training:** You will get a comprehensive training on different capacities' equipment and leadership as well as deployment related courses in online- and in-person trainings.
- **Exercise:** Before getting out in mission our team will participate in a large-scale field exercise to train in a real mission setting and to enhance interoperability between the different medical capacities and the host nation support.
- **"Ready-to-deploy" status** is actually defined by the European Commission as for mid of 2026.

Deployment Structure Description:

The rescEU EMT project is developed to strengthen the response capacity of the EUCPM with twenty-one medical capacities or specialised care teams, which will be established, trained, WHO-certified, and kept operational by Belgium, France, Germany, Italy, Luxembourg, Portugal, Romania, and Türkiye under the lead of the rescEU desk of the European Commission. The project started in December 2022 and the capacities will be ready for deployment latest in September 2026.
